#### PURPOSE

To give professional recognition and encourage client participation to excellence in design.

#### ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

All submittals must be constructed commissioned projects that have progressed to near state of completion, with the exception of Category 8. Only projects designed by SARA members or firms with one or more SARA members are eligible. (SARA Membership form included in order to satisfy this requirement.) Previous CCSARA award winning entries may not be resubmitted. Team projects will be treated as if presented by a single firm and will be judged as an individual project.

#### CATEGORIES

Entries shall be labeled in one of the following categories for the appropriate judging:

1. **HOUSING** Projects of all types including Single and Multi-Family Residences, Dormitories, Retirement Homes
2. **INSTITUTIONAL** Projects including Health Care, Educational, Governmental, Recreational and Religious Buildings
3. **COMMERCIAL** Projects including Office Buildings, Retail Centers and Financial Buildings
4. **INDUSTRIAL / MANUFACTURING** Facilities
5. **INTERIOR ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN** Projects
6. **REHABILITATION / REMODELING** Projects
7. **INTERNATIONAL** Projects
8. **PROJECTS IN DESIGN PHASE**
9. **ARCHITECTURAL FIRM AWARD** for California Firms submitting a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of seven (7) constructed projects designed with a SARA member on staff who has been a SARA member a minimum of ten (10) years.

#### JURY / JUDGING

The Jury will consist of at least three (3) architects and/or other industry professionals. Decisions of the Jury shall be final. None of the Jury members may submit entries for Judging or be associated with a firm submitting entries.

## DECLARATION OF INTENT

Entrants can apply for Membership by requesting a Membership Application and be eligible to submit as a CCSARA member to the 2006 CCSARA Design Awards Program. \$95 introductory fee included in the \$175.00 initial non member fee.
